Exclusive oak wood from the lagoons in and around Venice. The numerous wooden posts protruding from the water, known as «Briccole», serve navigation or as boat moorings. Every 5 to 10 years, they must be renewed due to corrosion. The oak wood, marked by seawater, mussels, and shipworms, has the color of antique oak and exhibits a unique patina. The fact that each of the approximately 10-meter-long posts erodes in different ways makes each section a one-of-a-kind piece. Whether in solid wood or as veneer, this material, with its tactile and aesthetic qualities, is an extraordinary choice for unique surfaces.
