## Powder coating on MDF

Solvent-free powder coating is widely used in the metal industry due to its numerous advantages. This environmentally friendly finishing process is now also applicable to wood. Using spray guns, fine color powder is electrostatically charged and applied to the substrate. Subsequently, the coated elements pass through infrared ovens, where the powder crosslinks and cures. Excess powder is recycled, resulting in uniform, edge-encompassing, scratch-resistant, highly durable, and seamless surfaces that are free from odors and other emissions. Powder-coated surfaces can be produced in almost any desired design, shape, and color.
